

What is a **BID**?

A Business Improvement District (BID) enables groups of businesses to commission projects that will lead to improvements in their local trading environment, funded through an additional levy charged through the business rates system.

The funding raised from the levy is ring fenced and held locally by an accountable body (Groundwork in the case of Gadbrook Park) and invested in added value projects and services. The projects and services are all commissioned and delivered under the governance and direction of the Gadbrook Park business community. The funds raised cannot be used to support or pay for services that are a statutory obligation of the public sector.

The Gadbrook Park Business Improvement District is a partnership between the businesses on Gadbrook Park, Cheshire West and Chester Council, Groundwork and a range of partner organisations. Since 2004, when the legislation to enable BIDs was introduced, more than 300 BIDs have been approved by companies across the UK.

The first Gadbrook Park BID was approved in 2009, with subsequent second and third BIDs approved in 2014 and 2019 respectively. During this time, the BID has successfully delivered a range of improvement projects for Gadbrook Park. The projects have included: upgrading the image of Gadbrook Park, reducing crime in the area, tackling access and egress issues and providing a range of business support and inward investment services.

What can the BID do for your business?

The Gadbrook Park Business Improvement District is broken down in to three themes, with a range of services and projects designed to benefit businesses focused within each one:

Theme One: Safe and Secure Theme Two: A Connected and Supported Business Park Theme Three: A Greener, Cleaner and Sustainable Trading Environment

Theme One: Safe and Secure

Gadbrook Park Security Service

The Gadbrook Park BID makes a significant investment in to a resourced security service provided by Alpha Omega Securities. Ensuring Gadbrook Park is as secure as possible, mobile security guards patrol the Business Park and Business Centre between 7pm through to 7am on weekdays and 24/7 throughout weekends and bank holiday periods. The security cabin is located at the entrance to the Business Centre. A consistent security service is also provided over the Bank Holiday weekends, Easter weekend and over the Christmas and New Year Period. If a security risk is identified outside of any normal hours, mobile security guards can be summoned immediately until no longer needed. Security guards at a range of companies on Gadbrook Park including Roberts, Barclays and The Hut Group all have radios to communicate and ensure that security patrols are as interlinked as possible with the Alpha Omega security guards.

CCTV and ANPR Cameras

The Gadbrook Park BID has funded an ANPR (Auto Number Plate Recognition) camera at the entrance to Gadbrook Park to log every car number plate that comes on to the site, as well as the dedicated five camera CCTV system across the Business Park. This ensures that security is at the highest level on Gadbrook Park. In the event that you fall foul of a crime on Gadbrook Park, you can request permission for CCTV footage to be sent to the police as part of the investigation please ring 01606 723175 or email GadbrookBID@groundwork.org.uk.

How do I make a request for CCTV?

- Give details of the date, approximate time and the location of the crime. A map with the precise location circled of where the incident occurred is often useful.
- Provide a brief description of the offence, eg. Anti-social behaviour, burglary, vehicle related crime, theft and damage, traffic offences and incidents.
- Provide a police crime reference number, as well as the name and contact details of the police officer that is handling the case. The police station that the footage needs to be delivered to is also useful.

What happens to my request once received?

- Once all details are received by the BID Team, a formal request to the CCTV monitoring station is made.
- Images are downloaded to DVD and sent directly to the named contact at Cheshire Police (supplied in the data request) to be reviewed.

Only requests that relate to the prevention and detection of crime will be processed and all images will be sent directly to Cheshire Police.







Keyholding Service

The Gadbrook Park BID offers a free Key Holding Service provided by Alpha Omega for Gadbrook Park businesses. If you would like to take advantage of this service, all you need to do is register with Alpha Omega and provide your contact details (contact name, phone number, company name and company address). Private Parking Enforcement Scheme And Parking Deterrents

Businesses on Gadbrook Park can be part of a private parking enforcement scheme to deter individuals parking in private company car parking spaces that they are not authorised to park in. Businesses will receive signage to display in their private car parks, as well as instructions on how to report unauthorised vehicles in any car parking spaces - the owners of which will then receive a fine. 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Gadbrook Park Employee Incentive Scheme

Being a member of the Gadbrook Park BID entitles you to a number of discounts on attractions and services.

There is a 20% discount on Leisure Packages at Brio Leisure (this comprises both the Rudheath Leisure Centre and Northwich Memorial Court, along with many other locations) and Gadbrook Park employees get a 20% discount on full membership (taking the cost down to £26 a month, or £5.60 a week). This can be used in any of the centres and extends to family members in the same household that are over 17. The discount will give you access to 12 Leisure centres, with unlimited use of all activities including the gym, swimming pool, fitness classes, off peak racquet sports, toning tables, sauna steam and the Jacuzzi.

All you need to do to take advantage and to gain access to all these benefits is show a payslip at the reception when joining and tell the member of staff that you are a part of the Gadbrook Park BID.

Other offers for Gadbrook Park Businesses include a discount for all employees on Gadbrook Park at Rudheath M.O.T Centre (10% off all work and service and £10 off an MOT, as well as a free collection service), plus 10% off bookings at Go Ape in Delamere Forest. To take up these discounts, you just need to take some identification from where you work.

The Gadbrook Park BID holds a number of events and networking opportunities throughout the year. 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Theme Three: A Greener, Cleaner and Sustainable Trading Environment

Grounds Maintenance And Visual Aesthetics

The Gadbrook Park BID has an ongoing landscape maintenance scheme with a local company to ensure the Business Park is kept in good condition visually. The BID also utilises both a local organisation and the Community Payback scheme to conduct various litter picks and general grounds cleansing across the Business Park. A full planting and maintenance schedule is implemented across Gadbrook Park, including maintenance of the roundabout near the Business Centre, maintenance of the signage at the entrance to the business park and the business centre, maintaining the seating areas across the business park and business centre, and the continued upkeep of the pond area. Directional signage to Gadbrook Park on the A556 is also regularly cleansed. During the summer months, over 20 hanging baskets are installed across Gadbrook Park to provide a vibrant splash of colour for employees and visitors to enjoy.

Regular image audits are undertaken across the entire area by the Business Park Manager on a reoccurring basis, identifying areas for improvement and ensuring the Business Park looks its best for employers, employees and visitors alike.

Gadbrook Park Walking Routes

A number of different walking trails and routes have been created on Gadbrook Park to provide a welcome break for workers to stretch their legs at lunchtime. With three different routes taking 10 minutes, 15 minutes or half an hour respectively, take in the surrounding scenery at local Rudheath Park or see what wildlife you can spot on a relaxing stroll along the nearby canal.
